Arctic Paper and EU Deforestation Regulation

On 19th of April 2023, the EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR) was adopted by EU Parliament's plenary. According to the voting at EU Parliament on the 17th of December 2025, the EUDR are postponed and will apply on the 30th of December 2026.

Arctic Paper will now wait for the revision of the EUDR procedures until the end of April 2026.

Arctic Paper is sourcing pulp and pulpwood, which are used for our paper production, from various suppliers. Arctic Paper is aware of our obligations in relation to the EUDR and communicates the issue with the various suppliers to ensure compliance. All our suppliers are confirming that they are or will be compliant with the EUDR before the regulation enters into application.

The Arctic Paper EUDR Team is now reviewing current procedures and measures to secure compliance with EUDR. The risk assessment and risk mitigation framework are under evaluation to secure regulation fulfilment.

The Arctic Paper mills (Arctic Paper Grycksbo AB in Sweden, Arctic Paper Kostrzyn S.A. in Poland, and Arctic Paper Munkedals AB in Sweden) holds FSC® CoC as well as PEFC CoC certificates and our compliance with the EUTR are audited by respective national authorities.
